MAN HUNT CATCHES QUARRY

Albert McDonald, Alleged Till Tapper, Run Down by Crowd.

With the aid of the old-fashioned hue and cry, Albert McDonald, 24 years old, who calls Toledo his home, was arrested in Delray yesterday. McDonald is alleged to have tapped the till in Gunsberg's butcher shop, 2214 West Jefferson avenue, and had bolted up the street. The cry of "stop thief" was raised and the crowd grew larger and larger as the chase lengthened.

McDonald was caught after a pursuit of three blocks and the crowd started to kick and beat him. Louis Gunsberg recovered the \$17 taken from the cash register. McDonald was turned over to Detectives Bowden and Thomas and locked up in Delray station. He had \$37.
