

# Eli Friedman, MD, specialist in pediatrics

Funeral services for Dr. Eli Friedman, 82, of 540 Dudley rd., Newton, will be held at 11 a.m. tomorrow in Temple Mishkan Tefila, Newton. He died at home Tuesday following a long illness.

Dr. Friedman was born in Russia and came to this country in 1902. He was graduated cum laude from Tufts University Medical School in 1913.

He published many technical papers dealing with tuberculosis, polio, neurological conditions,

bronchial gland infections, antihistamine medication and tubercular reaction, all based on clinical research into children's diseases.

Dr. Friedman was formerly chief of pediatrics at Boston City Hospital and Beth Israel Hospital and held emeritus professorships at Tufts and Boston University Schools of Medicine.

Besides his wife, Edith (Rosenberg), he leaves two daughters, Mrs. Seymour Shalek of Brookline and Mrs. Joseph Alpert of Westfield, N.J., and nine grandchildren.
