MARRIAGE OF MOSZEK ICEK BARON AND ESTERA DUTKIEWICZ IN 1893, RADOSZYCE

It took place in Radoszyce on 28th of October, 1893 at 8 pm. We were informed that a religious marriage ceremony was performed in the Radoszyce synagogue in presence of witnesses: Chaskel Klaper, age 78 and Alter Lipman, age 68, both Talmudic scholars residing in Radoszyce. The fiancé was Moszek Icek (two names) Baron, a bachelor age 21, a son of Lewin Baron and Perla nee Goldberg, residing in Radoszyce; and the fiancée: Estera Dutkiewicz, 21 a daughter of Icek Dutkiewicz and Cywia nee Jurberg. Their daughter resides with the Dutkiewiczes in Radoszyce. The marriage was preceded by three announcements in the Radoszyce synagogue: on October 2nd, 9^{th,} and 16th of the current year. The newlywed stated they had not signed any prenuptial agreement.

The religious marriage ceremony was performed by Rabbi Hilem Finkler of the Radoszyce Rabbinic area.
