

BIRTH OF ABRAM JANKIEL BARON IN 1901 TO MOSZEK AND ESTERA NEE DUTKIEWICZ IN RADOSZYCE

It took place Radoszyce on April 13, 1901 at 11 am. Moszek Baron, 20, a tradesman residing in Radoszyce, came in person accompanied by two residents of Radoszyce, both religious scholars: Josek Klaper, 60, and Alter Lipman, 60.

Moszek Baron presented a male infant born in Radoszyce to his legal wife Estera, 27, nee Dutkiewicz on the 19<sup>th</sup> of April/6<sup>th</sup> of April of the current year at 9 am.

At the religious ceremony the boy was named ABRAM JANKIEL (name spelled in Russian and Polish).

This signed certificate is given to the presenter and his witnesses.

Illegible signatures in Yiddish of the witnesses, and the clerk of the Radoszyce Civil Registrar
