BIRTH OF CHAIM BARON ON AUGUST 8, 1841

(Translated from Polish)

It took place in Radoszyce at 8 am on August 24, 1841. Maeir Baron, a salesman age 43, a Radoszyce resident came in person accompanied by his two Jewish witnesses also residing in Radoszyce: Chaim Zygbaum, a teacher, age 50, and Szmul Wajsfus, a cantor age 67. He informed that a male infant was born to his wedded wife age 38 (name illegible, maiden name illegible) at 5 am on August 8, 1841. After the circumcision ceremony the boy was named CHAIM.
