

BIRTH OF HAIM HIL TO IZRAEL BARON AND DWOJRA ON OCTOBER 26, 1853 IN RADOSZYCE

It took place in Radoszyce on the 21st of October/November 2nd, 1853 at 3 pm.

Izrael Baron, 50, a Jew residing in Radoszyce came in person accompanied by two Jewish witnesses residing in Radoszyce: Haskel Klapper, 49, a religious scholar, and Berek Mitler, 57, a small shopkeeper.

Izrael Baron showed us a male infant born in Radoszyce to his legal wife Dwojra, 44, on October 14th/26th of the current year.

At the bris ceremony the boy was named HAIM HIL.

This signed certificate is given to the father and his witnesses.
