

BIRTH OF HIL JOSEK BARON IN 1858, VILLAGE OF GROBLA, RADOSZYCE PARISH, POLAND

It took place in Radoszyce on the 30th of December/11 of January 1858 at 1 pm. Rywen Baron, a Jew age 28, a laborer, resident of the village of Grobla of the local parish, came accompanied by two Jewish witnesses residing in Radoszyce: Haskiel Klapper, a scholar age 54, and Berek Miller, a small shopkeeper, age 60. Rywen Baron presented a male infant born at 2 am in the village of Grobla to his legal wife Cypra age 25, on 23rd of December/ 4th of January of the current year (1858). At the bris ceremony the boy was named Hil Josek.
