

BIRTH OF JOSEL BARON, OCTOBER 12, 1827 IN RADOSZYCE

(Translation from Polish)

It took place in the town of Radoszyce. On October 13, 1827 Major Baron, age 35, a local Jew, a cantor of the synagogue came in person accompanied by two Jewish witnesses residing in Radoszyce, both small shop keepers : Szmul Gancarski, age 34 and Icyk Gancarski, age 30. Major Baron presented a male infant born in Radoszyce on October 12, of the current year; at 4 pm to his wedded wife Perla age 25. At the circumcision ceremony the boy was named JOSEL BARON.
