

BIRTH OF LEJZOR MEJER BARON IN 1855, RADOSZYCE, POLAND

It took place in the town of Radoszyce on 14/27 April, 1855 at 4 pm. A Jewish grain dealer, Rywen Baron, age 26, came in person accompanied by two Jewish witnesses residing in Radoszyce: Haskiel Klapper age 51, a scholar, and Berele Miller, age 57, a small shopkeeper. Rywen Baron presented to us a male infant born to his legal wife Cypra, age 25 on April 7/20 at 2 pm of the current year.

At the bris ceremony the boy was named Lejzor Mejer.
