BIRTH CERTIFICATE OF LEWI BARON BORN IN RADOSZYCE, POLAND IN 1845

(Translation from Polish)

It took place in Radoszyce on the 16th February of 1845 at 3 pm. A local Jewish trader age 19, Rywen Baron came in person accompanied by two Jewish witnesses: Haim Zygbaum, age 55, a teacher, and Berele Szegir, a shoemaker age 34, both residing in Radoszyce. Rywen Baron presented a male infant born in Radoszyce on the 14th of February of the current year at 7 pm, to his wife Cypra, age 20, nee Chorowich. At the bris ceremony the male infant was named Lewi.
