

BIRTH OF TWIN SONS: NUCHEM LEYBA BARAN AND HERSHL BARAN IN RADOSZYCE ON  
OCTOBER 26TH, 1841 TO IZRAEL BARAN AND CYRLA

It took place in Radoszyce on October 28<sup>th</sup>, 1841 at 10 am.

Izrael Baran, 31, a Jewish small shopkeeper residing in Radoszyce came in person accompanied by two Jewish witnesses, residents of Radoszyce: Chaim Zygbaum, 50, a religious scholar, and Szmul Waigas, 67, a cantor.

Izrael Baran showed us identical male twins born to his legal wife Cyrla, 33, on October 13/26 of the current year.

At the bris ceremony the boys were named: NUCHEM LEYBA AND HERSZL.
