BIRTH OF A DAUGHTER ADES ON MAY 29, 1839 IN RADOSZYCE

(Translated from Polish)

It took place in the town of Radoszyce at 5 pm on June 4th, 1839. Maier Baron, a Jewish laborer age 44, came in person accompanied by two Jewish witnesses: Haim Zygbaum, age 50, a teacher, and Jurek Czarnobrodzki, a tradesman age 48, both residing in Radoszyce. Maeir Baron informed us that a female infant was born in Radoszyce on May 29, 1839 to his wedded wife Perla, age 42. The girl was named ADES.

This certificate was given to the presenter and witnesses, and signed in Yiddish by: Haim Zygbaum, Jurek Czarnobrodzki, and Maeir Baron.
