## DIVORCE CERTIFICATE FOR JOSEK BARON AND DWOJRA NEE RICHTER ISSUED IN 1900

## DIVORCE OF JOSEK BARON FROM DWOJRA

(OVAL SEAL OF THE JUSTICE OF PEACE and his initials)

It took place in Radoszyce at noon on June 25<sup>th</sup>, 1900. Josek Baron, a permanent resident of Radoszyce, 32, and Dwojra Baron nee Richter, born in the town of Przedborz came in person accompanied by witnesses: Moszek Tenenbaum, 44, and Izrael Finkler, 24. They showed a copy of the decision of the Piotrkow Circuit Court of March 30<sup>th</sup>, 1899 stating that the marriage of Josek and Dwojra that had taken place in Przedborz on 17th/29th of August, 1884 was dissolved. They asked for a divorce certificate.

It was clear from the Piotrkow Circuit Court resolution that the spouses agreed to divorce in the presence of a Rabbi. Therefore the Court decision is legal, and on the basis of the article 189 about matrimony of the year 1836, and in force the above mentioned Court decision, we issued a certificate of divorce, and handed it to the interested parties and witnesses.
