

MARRIAGE OF HIL JOSEK BARON AND DWOJRA LEWI IN 1882, RADOSZYCE

It took place in Radoszyce on the 24<sup>th</sup> of March, 1882 at 8 pm.

We inform that a religious marriage ceremony took place in Radoszyce on March 24<sup>th</sup> at 5 pm between Hil Josek Baron, 23, a bachelor, son of Rubin and Cypojra Baron residing in Radoszyce, and Dwojra Lewi, a virgin of 19, daughter of Lejba and Rojza Lewi also residents of Radoszyce. The religious ceremony was conducted by Rabbi Hil Finkler of the Radoszyce Rabbinical Circuit, and in presence of Jewish witnesses: Haskiel Klapper, 73, and Alter Lipman, 52, both religious scholars residing in Radoszyce.

Three announcements were made prior to this marriage in the local synagogue: on January 6<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> of the current year. The parents of both parties agreed to this marriage. The newlywed stated they did not sign any prenuptial agreement.

This certificate is issued to the newlywed and witnesses, and is signed in Russian for Hil Finkler, Haskiel Klapper, Hil Josek Baron, Dwojra Lewi, and Alter Lipman.
