MARRIAGE OF JOSEK BARON AND SURA ITA WAJNBERG IN 1900, RADOSZYCE

It took place in Radoszyce on May 14<sup>th</sup>, 1900. It was announced that in the presence of witnesses: Moszek Tennenbaum, age 40, and Moszek Rozenbaum age 45, both dealers in Radoszyce, a religious marriage ceremony had taken place between Josek Baron, a bachelor age 33, a son of deceased Lewin Baron and Perla nee Goldberg residing in Radoszyce, and Sura Ita Wajnberg, an unmarried woman of 35, a daughter of Shaja and Jacheda nee Wajnberg (?). Three announcements were made before this marriage in the Radoszyce synagogue: on April 29th/May 11th, May 6th/May 19th, and May 13<sup>th</sup>/May 26<sup>th</sup> of the current 1900 year.

The religious marriage ceremony was conducted by Rabbi Hilem Finkler of the Radoszyce Rabbinate area. The newlywed stated they had not signed any prenuptial agreement.
